The staff has been hard at work this winter, having been blessed with very mild weather. We have been out pruning trees and opening drainage to make sure we keep up with the heavy rains we have received. When weather has been gloomy, we have been indoors working on equipment and refurbishing course accessories.

During the month of February, we will be working on a few different projects when the weather cooperates.

- We will be applying herbicides to all warm season grasses to eradicate winter weeds as well as prevent broadleaf and grassy weeds next season. We must do this during sunny days as the plants take up the chemicals much better in the cold weather when it is sunny. This will normally impact some winter golfing. We will try to keep you informed on when this will take place.
- We also have some tree removal to complete. Dead trees will be removed as needed around the golf course.
- We will be lighting our burn pile Monday, January 30th.
- Other projects include cleaning up areas inside, outside and around the maintenance facility, equipment preventative maintenance and course maintenance and repairs.
