Greetings to Membership,

The Men's Member Guest is scheduled for Sept 15th and 16th. Please don't hesitate if interested in signing up. The afternoon is approaching a full field. Please complete application and pay all fees. Entry fee is \$295 which includes Kentucky sales tax. Anyone who has signed up by August 5th will have their shirt sizes guaranteed. Anyone who drops after shirts have been ordered will have their entry fee refunded minus shirt cost. For those who have filled out an application and not paid fees, please do so as soon as possible.

Regular members (including Seniors)	\$500
Swim/Tennis members	\$130 (One month's dues)

The \$500 assessment may be paid in one of three methods:

1. One-time payment of \$500
2. Five monthly payments of \$100
3. **Ten monthly payments of \$50***

The \$130 assessment may be paid in one of three methods:

1. One-time payment of \$130
2. Two monthly payments of \$65
3. Five monthly payments of \$26

Paxton Cup Team Information

There are lots of changes this year to the annual Paxton Cup Matches. Hopefully these changes will all be for the better and will bring back the fun that has escaped them over the last few years. I'm sure everyone has heard both facts and rumors regarding how they will be handled this year. Here's how they will go:

- Rolling Hills WILL be hosting the Cup Matches on 9/29/18 (barring any complications with the new greens).
- The Cup Matches are going from a two-day, 36 hole event to a one-day 27 hole event.
- Format will be 9 holes of Alternate shot, 2 man teams just like in the past but with only 9 holes followed by 18 holes of individual match play.
- The same 4 teams as in the past will be participating, RHCC, Silos, CCoP, and Paxton.
- There will be 12 players and 2 alternates on the team.
- There will be no charge to sign up for the Cup Team this year as in years past.

All that being said, Josh Rhodes (current Club Champion) is the Captain of the Cup Team. Kevin Rhinehart and Mark Moore will be handling the qualification process. To establish the 12 person team:

- Current Club Champion is Captain and automatically qualified.
- The next 9 spots will be filled by a qualifying process.
- The final 2 spots and 2 alternates will be filled by Captain's picks, either voted on by the team or chosen by the captain. This is at the discretion of the captain.
- Next year the process will likely go back to the way its been handled in the past. This process is just for this year.

Not having an open golf course is obviously an issue getting the qualifying process going. We have decided the best way to do it is to set 3 qualifying dates. These will be held at other local courses. We will have a sign-up process, get a block of tee times starting at noon, and just go out and play as a group to qualify. Very simply the 9 lowest scores from these qualifiers will be the 9 that make the team. You can play in 1 and use that score, 2 and use your lower score, or play in all 3 and use your lowest score as your qualifying score. These are the qualifying dates:

August 12	Calvert City Country Club
August 26	Paxton Park
September 9	Rolling Hills (Paxton Park if RHCC still closed)

Wooldridge Cup
