The one-time assessment set by the Board of Directors of Rolling Hills is as follows:

Regular members (including Seniors) \$500

Swim/Tennis members \$130 (One month's dues)

The \$500 assessment may be paid in one of three methods:

1. One-time payment of \$500
2. Five monthly payments of \$100
3. Ten monthly payments of \$50*

The \$130 assessment may be paid in one of three methods:

1. One-time payment of \$130
2. Two monthly payments of \$65
3. Five monthly payments of \$26

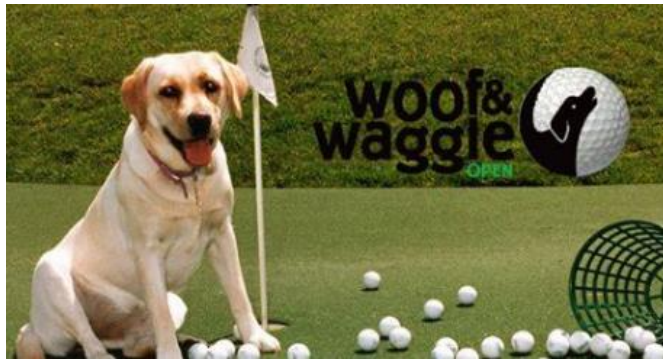
